In English, we will be writing our own diary entries, which will be based on our core text 'My Story: The Great Plague: A London Girl's Diary.' Additionally, once we have completed our Historical research, we will be evidencing our learning by writing our own newspaper reports.

Our Maths focus for the term will be to consolidate our calculation understanding, as well as to begin to look at fractions, decimals and percentages.

As always, we will continue to develop our speed in arithmetic as well.

In Science we'll be looking at Living Things and their Habitats.

Our Art focus will be on sculpture, specifically the Fire of London Monument.

In DT we will be experimenting with our cooking skills.

In RE we will be looking at Christianity and thinking about how significant it is that Mary was Jesus' mother.

In PSHE we will be continuing to use the Jigsaw scheme and will be celebrating differences in our lives.
