


# We Could be Heroes

This Term we will be conducting our learning through the theme of heroes; both the super and the every-day kind.

We are starting the topic with the story 'Eliot Midnight Superhero'. The story is all about Eliot who by day, is a quiet boy who likes to read. But when the clock strikes midnight, Eliot is a superhero!

We will be using this as a stimulus for our writing as well as other exciting superhero texts such as Super Daisy! We will continue to use our phonic sounds, (learning and using Phase 5 sounds) as well as punctuating our sentences correctly.



We are also working very hard on forming our letters and numbers correctly.

## Fabulous Finish!

Our fabulous finish will be confirmed later on in the term.



In Maths we will be working with numbers up to 20, building on previous learning; focusing on addition and subtraction using the part whole model. . We will be looking at how numbers are made up of tens and ones, finding one more and one less. We will be writing, ordering and comparing numbers and also naming 2D and 3D shapes.

In Science we will be looking at the seasons and the changes that happen through each one as well as learning about animals including humans, exploring our senses and labelling our body!

In DT we will be building free standing structures. We will be looking to build a skyscraper or a super hero's hideout. If you have any junk modelling at home that you could spare us, we would really appreciate it for example, kitchen roll tubes, cereal boxes, egg boxes, yoghurt pots etc.

In History we will be looking at events beyond living memory that are significant nationally and globally, for example Bonfire Night.

In Religious Education we are looking at Christianity and The Christmas Story.
